ROYAL APPOINTMENT

On behalf of the Royal Laos Kingdom In Exile and the Ai-Lao People of the Shan State, we are honored to appoint you, effective immediately, as **Chief Political & Legal Advisor** for both de jure governments.


Your Honor's aid, assistance, direction and counsel will be meaningfully significant in the following areas:

1. Securing funding for our governments' primary objective of gaining sovereign independence as Nation-States under the 1933 Montevideo Convention.
2. Finding suitably qualified buyers for our asset (aurum) using the good offices of the Royal Borneo Nations' Treasury and Central Bank.
3. Initiating legal action on behalf of the RLGE at the International Court of Justice, The Hague, Netherlands, and the International Court of Human Rights, against the present dictatorial, communist regime of Laos under the control of Vietnam which the Lao people cannot tolerate and many of the world's leaders chose to ignore rather than oppose.
4. Securing membership in the Indigenous Peoples Forum of the United Nations without compromising the 1933 Montevideo Convention.


5. Establishing a significantly sizeable loyal security force to guard our borders from external and internal aggression from the present communist regime.
6. Obtaining assent and consent to signing Treaties of Peace, Partnership and Prosperity with friendly nation-states and American Indian governments.
7. Authoring, drafting and revising our written Constitution.
8. Establishing three organs of state – Executive, Legislature and Judiciary.
9. Preparing banking and financial control centers with adequate and appropriate licensing requirements.
10. Establishing a Royal Consultative Council solely for the purpose of policy-making.
11. Preparing and advising us on other issues that will inevitably require our attention.

Understandably, Your Honor's compensation will be significant given the task at hand. We shall most definitely address this specific issue when our liquidity/funding is assured and established.
